PLAYOFFS AND TIE BREAKER PROCEDURES

Top 2 teams from each pool advance to Playoffs.

4th. Place team from each pool will ref. Quarterfinals, 1 game 25 pts.

Top teams in pool play will ref. any tiebreakers in pool

Tiebreakers are 1 game to 15 points.

Quarter finals are 1 game to 25, no cap. Semis/Finals are 2 of 3, 25 pts, 3rd. game 15.

1st. Place team in each pool will be seeded 1st 2nd 3rd and 4th (according to win loss record, if tie within the pool, than points will determine 1st.)

2nd. Place teams in each pool will be seeded 5th 6th 7th and 8th (according to win loss record than points.) if 2 teams tie within the pool, tiebreaker procedures will apply, (**1st. Pl. team will ref.**) Tiebreaker winners will have the over all lower seed. If 2 teams tie for 2nd within the same pool, and 1 of those tied teams in pool play has won both of their games at head to head competition, then that winning team will advance. (**No Tie Breaker Procedure**) If they have split on head to head competition then tiebreaker procedures will apply.

If all 4 teams tie in pool play for 1st. than tiebreaker procedures will apply. (1st. vs 4th.) (2nd. Vs 3rd.)

Winners will be seeded according to over all point differentials within each other.

In playoffs, 1st place teams will stay on their courts, 2nd place teams will move.

4th place teams ref on their courts, losers of 1/4's ref semis and losers of semis coinflip for reffing finals.

1 vs 8, 2 vs 7, 3 vs 6, 4 vs 5 is playoff seeding format.
